Rotary membership has been declining for several years. Now, the pandemic is exacerbating the situation. However, the situation is not hopeless. Evidence of this is the half-dozen clubs in Finland, which are steadily increasing their number of members. The number of members is also growing in Estonia.

This is clearly up to each club's own actions and activity. The right measures must be taken repeatedly and for a long-term.

We are now embarking on a 5-year member strategy. Once the strategy is implemented for these years to come, I believe the number of members will be approximately the same, or maybe a little lower than it is now, but the age structure will have changed. It brings new vitality to clubs.





The third wave of the covid pandemic in the form of the omicron variant is underway in Finland, Estonia and elsewhere in Europe. To the situation, I can only recommend the instructions of the authorities and behaving responsibly, as the Rotarians have done so far.

As writing this, the peak of the pandemic is timed to the turn of January-February, after which the trend is downward. I recommend holding club meetings as hybrid meetings.

Rotary Convention in June

Rotary Convention 4.-8. June in Houston, Texas, is the main annual event of the Rotary world. The event is open to all Rotarians and their families. It is worth monitoring the pandemic situation. I very much hope that the event can be organized.

To receive a district grant, the club must have made a donation to the TRF Annual Fund within the past three years and a club representative must have attended the District Rotary Foundation Seminar in November or the Zoom Seminar held in January 2022.
