- Jaetaan 3 osaan, 5 % kuluihin, 47,5 % Maailmanrahastoon, 47,5 % palautuu piirille. Piiri voi käyttää puolet klubeille annettuihin piiri apurahiin ja puolet Global Granteihin

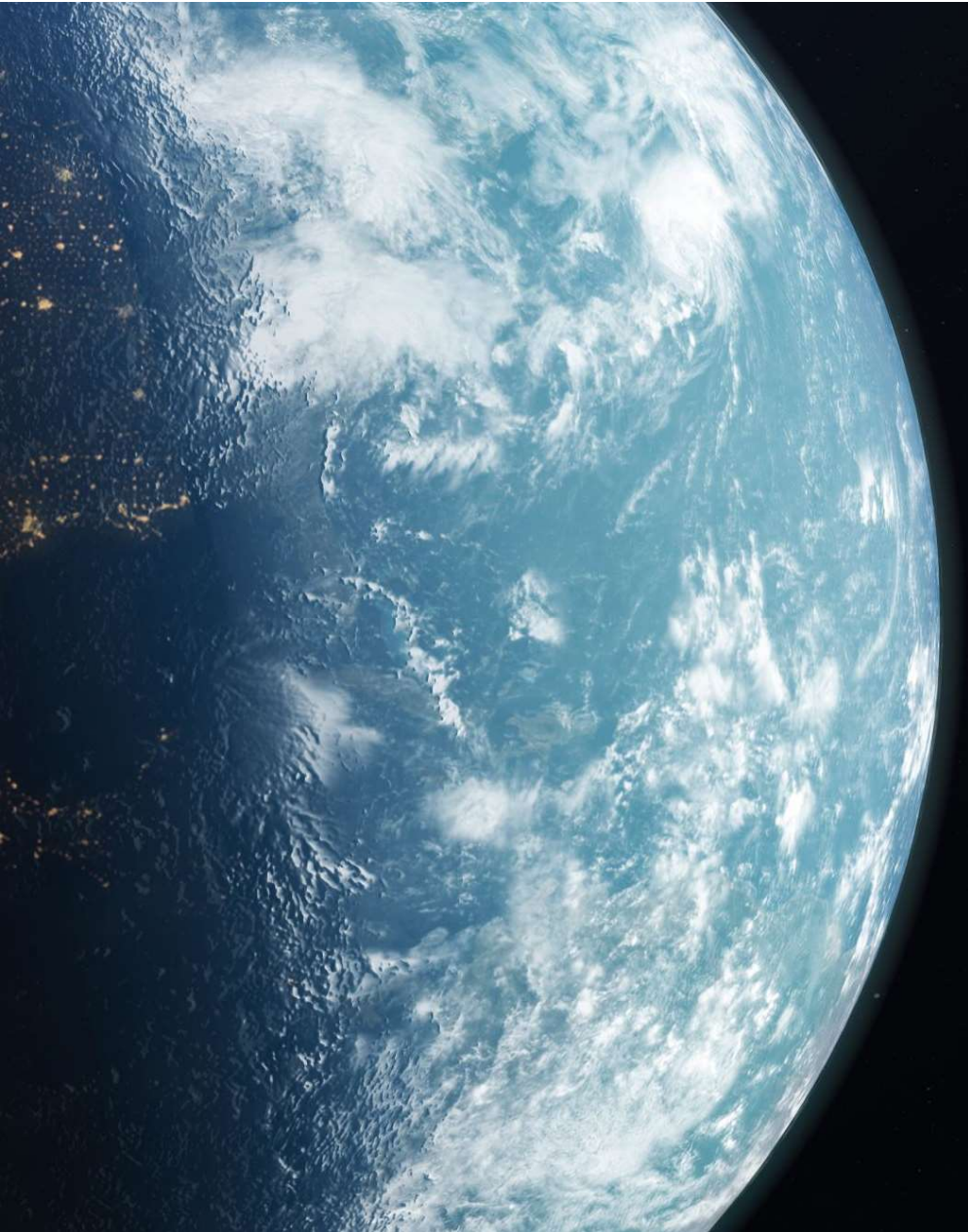


Rotaryn jäsenten tuki

STEWART COLE BLASIER

A career in foreign affairs is the reason why this Michigan man (Green Point) wishes to study at the University of Chile in Santiago. At George Washington University he studied Latin America's history, government, and economics. Speaks French and Spanish. Was U. S. Navy Tank Group Supply Officer. Studies leader at University of Illinois.



AUBREY GOLDSMITH DAVIES

To prepare for teaching of English in Vietnam, the New Haven, Connecticut, student will study at Cambridge University, England. He studied in 1942 at Yale University, where he also did graduate work. During war years he was a stationer of the American Field Service with the British Army in Burma. Winner of three scholarships.



VATOHE KALBIAN

Study of heart disease, preferably in an English college and hospital, is the aim of this native Palestinian. A four-language speaker—English, Arabic, American, and French—he is now a doctor at the Government Hospital in Nalbin, Palestine. Served on faculty at the American University of Beirut in Syria. Outside work: taxi driver, swimming, football, chess.



EVERETT T. ALCAN

"To be an intelligent citizen, I should understand and appreciate our European neighbors." That is why Mr. Alcan, of Detroit, Michigan, wishes to study at an English or French university. A graduate of Detroit College, he headed that school's science department last year. Twelve years most of his class he was outstanding student, athlete, and school leader.

This Waltham, Massachusetts, student will spend a year at Charles University in Czechoslovakia. Arrived with U. S. Marine Corps in Pacific. Purple Heart and Bronze Star Medal. One of U.
